



World Green Organisation and Synergy Group Announced the “Synergy Energy Efficiency Index”

Hong Kong, (14 November 2016) - World Green Organisation (WGO) and Synergy Group Holdings International Ltd (1539:HK) (Synergy Group), has announced the launch of the Synergy Energy Efficiency Index (Hong Kong), (SEEI). SEEI is developed by WGO in collaboration with the Energy and Environmental Policy Research Unit of the City University of Hong Kong, and sponsored by Synergy Group, one of the leading energy management contract providers in Asia and the first ESCO Company listed on the Hong Kong Stock Exchange.

As part of Synergy Group continuous effort in promoting carbon emission reduction in Hong Kong, the Group has sponsored the World Green Organisation in collaboration with the Energy and Environmental Policy Research Unit of City University of Hong Kong in developing SEEI.

SEEI examines the underlying causes of changes in energy consumption in both residential and commercial sectors in Hong Kong over the last decade. The main objective of the development of the index is to provide the society of Hong Kong a scientific tool in observing the trend, and to keep track of energy performance of each sector within Hong Kong.

Based on this year's analysis, SEEI score of Residential Sector is 97%. Using 2000 as a base year, SEEI revealed that 3% less energy was used compared to the past when performing the same activity in residential sector over the last decade (2000-2013). In terms of the Commercial Sector, SEEI score is 110%.



By using 2000 as a base year, SEEI has revealed that 10% more energy was consumed compared to the past when performing the same activity in commercial sector over the last decade (2000-2013).

“The proposed index provides scientific analysis on energy efficiency and helps draw important references to the trend in energy savings performance in different sectors of Hong Kong. This will help both the residential and commercial sectors to understand and benchmark their energy efficiency performance in related sectors.” said Lam.
